

APPENDIX D – ORIGINAL APPLICATION DESCRIPTION

ORIGINAL APPLICATION

Sydney Resolution Pty Ltd, the Proponent, sought consent for the temporary use of part of the existing vacant land at Glebe Island for the purpose of staging two, one day, popular concerts. The DA sought consent the temporary change of use of the land from port related activities, as no permanent building works were proposed. The proposal entailed the following:

- construction and dismantling periods for the temporary structures, over a period of 24 days from 17 December, 2011 – 10 January, 2012;
- a New Year's Eve concert for 44,000 patrons and to operate from 2pm 31 December 2011 until 3am, 1 January 2012;
- a second concert proposed to be held on the 3 January 2012 for 44,500 patrons and to operate from 2pm to midnight;
- establishment of a market village comprising 262 stalls;
- transport management plans relying on a mixture of rail, bus, private car and pedestrian access to the venue;
- identification of a helipad to provide emergency services as well as VIP access to the venue;
- use of the Old Glebe Island Bridge to provide pedestrian access to the site from the east;
- off-site carparking was proposed to be provided at Moore Park and patrons shuttled by bus across the CBD to the venue;
- bulk of patrons were expected to arrive via train and then to be shuttled by buses to the venue; and
- The project would create the equivalent of 8.6 Construction and 103.8 Operational full-time jobs.
