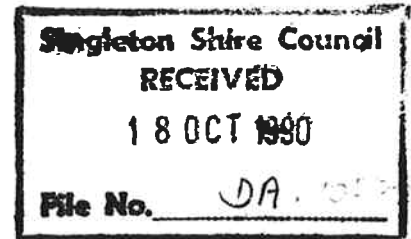

We are very worried about the safety of our children who travel to Singleton schools on the school bus, we know a lot of the workers from the mine site, would have started by 8 a.m. (which is the time the bus picks up) but the school bus returns home at 4 p.m. when a lot of the workers will be finishing for the day.
