



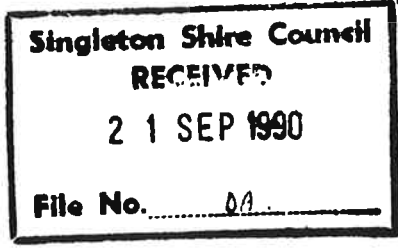

#### Development Application- Glennies Creek Coal Mine - EIS Document

Receipt of a copy of the Environmental Impact Statement documents is acknowledged together with the fact that a development application has been lodged with Singleton Shire Council.

This Council raises no objections to the EIS and confirms that electrical supply will be provided via existing 11kV distribution mains and a proposed extension of 66kV mains.

Following the EIS procedures and ultimate determination by yourselves and the Department of Environment and Planning, under Part IV of the EP & A Act, Shortland Electricity will have to carry out an environmental impact assessment on the alternate route of a 66kV line to provide supply to this project. This activity is carried out by Shortland Electricity under Part V of the EP & A Act.

To assist Council in selecting the most appropriate route and achieving agreements where necessary with independent land owners it is suggested that the approval given to the Development Application acknowledge the need for electrical supply and the necessary activities that Shortland Electricity will have to undertake.

Acceptance of additional power lines by land owners and the general community is becoming increasingly difficult and should be a consideration in the development application phase and not left solely to the supply authority to face the environmental and community criticism.

Council has initiated actions which may achieve changes to the EP & A Act which will resolve this approach. In the interim Council would appreciate your co-operation in a manner that will ensure that the supply of essential electricity to this project can be provided.
