RE: Referral to Heritage Council of Further Information report for the Haerses Road Sand Quarry – Modification 1 (DA 165-7-2005 MOD 1) also known as SSD 7737

I refer to your email dated 19 October 2017 providing a link to the Supplementary Response to Submissions Report provided by Dixon Sand for the above project.

The Heritage Council of NSW previously provided comments in letters dated 17 July 2017 and 27 July 2017. It is noted that the report *Haerses Road Quarry Extraction Area Modification Response to Request for Further Information* prepared by Umwelt Pty Ltd and dated October 2017, contains no heritage information. That is because the Heritage Council did not require any further information after clarification was provided about the location of items contained in the initial RTS report. It is noted that no additional conditions of consent were considered necessary to manage historical archaeology or heritage considerations in our correspondence dated 27 July 2017. Conditions recommended to DPE in our correspondence dated 17 July 2017 were:

- An appropriate research design and excavation methodology shall also be prepared by the nominated Excavation Director to support any mitigation measures identified. It shall be submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment for review and approval prior to works commencing.
- Results of any mitigation program must also be provided to the Department of Planning and Environment and Heritage Division within a year of the completion of archaeological works on site.
