RE: DA 165-7-2005 Sch. 3 Cond. 17 Haerses Road Quarry – Completion of 2-year Groundwater Monitoring Program in the MTSGS Buffer Zone

Dear Whom It May Concern,

Condition 17 of Schedule 3 of DA 165-7-2005 requires Dixon Sand to complete a baseline groundwater monitoring program which includes monthly monitoring of groundwater levels and quality within the Maroota Tertiary Sands Groundwater Source (MTSGS) buffer zone for a period no less than 2 years prior to commencing quarrying operations within the MTSGS buffer zone. This is to be undertaken in consultation with CLWD and to the satisfaction of the Secretary.

Dixon Sand has completed the abovementioned groundwater monitoring program and engaged Mr Peter Dundon from Dundon Consulting to carry out a review and presentation of baseline groundwater levels and quality data.

Consultation with CLWD was undertaken through a series of meetings during the consultation process for DA 165-7-2005 Modification 1 which resulted in the required scope of works outlined in Conditions 16 and 17.

Dixon Sand is submitting the report containing the reviewed baseline data of monitoring bores within the MTSGS buffer zone for the Secretary's approval. The report is contained in Attachment A of this letter.

A copy of the report has been submitted to CLWD (Natural Resources Access Regulator) and the correspondence is contained in Attachment B.

I trust that this satisfies the Department's requirement.
