I refer to your letter dated 15 February 2024, regarding the outstanding biodiversity credit obligations for the project under conditions 31, 32 and 33 of Schedule 3, for the Haerses Road Quarry (DA165-7-2005).

I note in your letter and in your response to a request for more information from the Department, you have now demonstrated you have met your remaining 89 biodiversity offset credits obligations under the consent for Vegetation type 1134 - *Scribbly Gum - Hairpin Banksia - Dwarf Apple heathy woodland on hinterland sandstone plateaux of the Central Coast, Sydney Basin Bioregion*.

This is based upon:

1. Statement for Conservation Fund Payment for an offset obligation (29 January 2024) - 57 credits;
2. Credit retirement report (17 January 2024) - 3 credits; and
3. Statement for Conservation Fund Payment for an offset obligation (25 May 2023) - 29 credits.
