Subject: Exemption to install road signs under condition 54A, Schedule 4

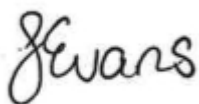
Dear Ms Hateley

I refer to your letter, dated 12 January 2026, requesting the Planning Secretary's agreement to waive the requirement to install intersection warning signs on the Castlereagh Highway, as required by condition 54A of Schedule 4 of the Cullen Valley Mine development consent (DA 200-5-2003).
