Wagga Wagga City Council requests that consideration be given to the *Wagga Wagga Local Infrastructure Contributions Plan 2019-2034*, Council's *Development Servicing Plan No 1: Sewerage Services (2013)*, and Council's *Development Servicing Plan – Stormwater (2007)*, in assessing the modification. It is requested that appropriate conditions are imposed to ensure the payment of s7.12 contributions under the Local Infrastructure Contributions Plan for the additional works, if the cost of works exceed \$100,000, and that a compliance certificate under s306 of the Water Management Act 2000 be obtained from Council for additional sewer and stormwater works/impacts if assessed as required.

With regards to water supply, it is noted that Riverina Water is the appropriate water authority and are responsible for issuing compliance certificates in relation to water supply works.

Council's Contributions Coordinator, Belinda Maclure, can assist in the calculation of contributions once your assessing officer has determined relevant matters to facilitate this, such as development floor area and cost of the carrying out of the development in accordance with Section 25J of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulations.
