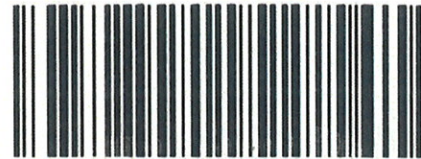

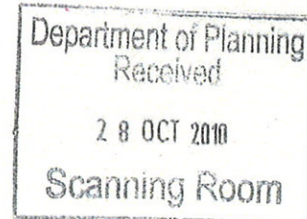

**REQUEST FOR CONDITION – BLAST MONITOR REPORTS
STRATFORD COAL MINE s75W MODIFICATION 4 (DA 23-98/99)**

Please accept this letter as a late submission on behalf of Council and residents in the Stratford community.

Council recently held a public meeting at Stratford and one issue that arose was for Council to request from the relevant State Agencies that following every mine blast that within a reasonable time period that the blast reports be made available to the public by the company's website.

The company undertakes blast monitoring and makes this information available to State Agencies. The community of Stratford would like to also be able to see the results as to exceedances and over blast pressures as recorded at the various monitors.

Council would therefore like to request that a condition be placed on the amended consent to require the company to place on their website the full blast reports within a reasonable time frame, say 14 days, from the date of the blast.
