SCHEDULE 1

The development consent (DA No. 262-09-01) granted by the Minister for Planning for the development of the Bald Hill Quarry Regional Landfill, near Jugiong, on 16 August 2002.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Delete condition 1.1 of schedule 2, and replace with the following:

1.1 The Bald Hill Quarry Regional Landfill (the Project) shall be carried out in accordance with:

- the Development Application No.262-09-01 lodged with the Department on 26 September 2001;
- the EIS prepared for the 'Bald Hill Quarry Regional Landfill' and associated documents prepared for the Applicant by R.W. Corkery & Co. Pty. Limited and dated September 2001;
- the Landfill Environmental Management Plan (LEMP) approved by the DEC;
- all supplementary material prepared by Charles Dearling, titled Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Study dated March 2002;
- modification application MOD 121-10-2006, dated 28 September 2006, and supporting information supplied by Bald Hill Quarry Pty Limited; and
- the conditions of consent granted by the Minister.

If there is any inconsistency between the above documents, the latter document shall prevail over the former to the extent of the inconsistency. However, the conditions of this consent shall prevail over all other documents to the extent of any inconsistency.

2. Delete condition 16.1 of schedule 2, and replace with the following:

16.1 The Applicant shall implement a Landfill Environmental Management Plan (LEMP) prepared in accordance with the DEC's *Environmental Guidelines: Solid Waste Landfills*, and to the satisfaction of the DEC.
3. Delete condition 17.1 of schedule 2, and replace with:

17.1 The Applicant shall prepare an Annual Environmental Management Report (AEMR) for the site, to the satisfaction of the Director-General, and provide a copy of the approved AEMR to all relevant government agencies and Council within 2 weeks of its approval.
4. Delete condition 31.2 of schedule 2 and replace with the following:

31.2 Monitoring sites shall be selected to monitor dust deposition rates at nearby sensitive receptors in accordance with *Australian Standard AS2922-1987 Ambient Air – Guide for Siting of Sampling Units*.
5. Delete the text from condition 48 of schedule 2 and replace with the following:

Rainfall and evaporation at the Premises, or alternative monitoring site approved by the DEC, must be measured and recorded in millimetres per 24 hour period at the same time each day.
6. Remove "Attachment 1 – Leachate Pond Specifications" from the consent.
