Thank you for making the time to come out and meet today, your effort is appreciated and hopefully you didn't have any problems catching your flight home. As per our discussions, can you please provide the following information:

1. completed Controlled Activity Application form (attached)
2. photographs of the outlet underneath Gate 6 to demonstrate that scouring has not occurred at the outlet point, and suitable modelling data to demonstrate that the new system will not result in increased velocity of flows at the outlet point (all we need is the current peak flow rate (m<sup>3</sup>/s) compared to the estimated peak flow rate for the culvert provided in Table 5-3 of your report).
3. addendum to the erosion & sediment control plan to show what control measures will be implemented during the enlargement of Basin 3 and the joining of basins 4 and 5 immediately upstream of the outlet to Kings Stockyard Creek.
4. a proposed maintenance schedule to ensure vegetation survival within the swales and to inspect for potential scour/undermining of the shotcrete walls
5. A copy of the engineering design for the slab and footings that abut swale 1.
6. Design detail for the proposed diversion weir downstream of Gate 6 (unless the weir is already in place. If it is existing please note in your submission).

Once the above information is received, we will begin processing the application. We will advise you of the fee which will need to be paid before the approval can be issued.

Tim has spoken with David Mooney from Dept. Planning this afternoon. David has advised that the CAA should not be issued until DoP has issued their approval. The CAA may be considered to be invalid if it is issued prior to DoP approval. The time frame to get the CAA issued will therefore depend on DoP.
