I refer to your submission of the General Cargo Handling Facility Condition 1.1B Report 2022, Revision 00, dated 28 February 2022, under schedule 2 clause 1.1B of the Development Application.

Schedule 2 clause 1.1B requires at five yearly intervals following commencement of operation of the General Cargo Handling Facility, that the Applicant submit a report to the Direct-General (now Planning Secretary) outlining the ongoing need for the facility if to be retained on site and remain operational.
