Description of proposed modification

Wambo Coal Pty Limited has identified an opportunity for the continuation, and improved efficiency, of the South Bates Extension Underground Mine by reorienting Longwalls 24 and 25, and adding Longwall 26. This section 4.55(1A) modification application would allow for the development of first workings associated with the reoriented Longwall 24.
