Re: Allied Mills Pty Limited – Modification of Flour and Maize Mill – MOD DA-318-12-2004-1 – Wollondilly LGA

Thank you for the opportunity to provide advice on MOD DA-318-12-2004-1. This is a response from NSW Department of Industry – Geological Survey of New South Wales (GSNSW). The Department of Primary Industries (incorporating advice from Agriculture and Fisheries) and the Forestry Corporation of NSW may respond separately.

Lot 2 DP 252362 adjacent to the subject site is identified in the State-wide Mineral Resource Audit under *Section 117(2) Direction 1.3 – Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries* of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* as the Maldon Shale Quarry, operated by Boral Limited.

While the Maldon Shale Quarry is currently not operating, the consent authority should consider future extraction of the clay/shale resource. In this regard GSNSW have no specific issues to raise with the proposed Modification to DA-318-12-2004-1.

General Information

Consolidated Coal Lease (CCL) 716 and Coal Authorisation (AUTH) 206 held by Endeavour Coal Pty Limited exists over a broad regional area that includes the subject site. Identification of the titles is to make the consent authority aware that there are other stakeholders with interests in the region.

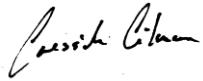
