Good afternoon Melissa,

In response to your emails inviting submissions on DA 35/98 MOD 5 - Chlor-Alkali Plant, Botany Industrial Park, please see below.

We asked that the applicant provide the approach they planned to assess and ensure risk (including cumulative on-site risk) of the proposed changes is reduced SFARP. This request is copied in Appendix 7 of the document "Botany Repack Facility Environmental Assessment DA 35/98 Modification 5". This has not yet been adequately addressed.

If DP&E determine to approve the DA, SafeWork NSW suggests that the following conditions of consent be included:

1. Prior to completion of detailed design, applicant must consult with SafeWork NSW on the identification and implementation of the controls to reduce risks SFARP.
2. Prior to operating the new modification, applicant must implement the controls required to reduce risk SFARP.
