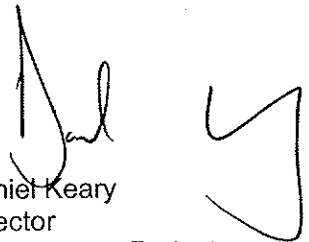


Modification of Minister's Approval

SCHEDULE 1

Proponent:	NSW Roads and Traffic Authority
Approval:	Granted by the Minister Assisting the Minister for Infrastructure and Planning on 20 July 2004 under Section 115B of the <i>Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979</i>
For the following:	The Newell Highway Moree Town Centre Bypass
Modification:	MP 08_0017 MOD 2 - Modification to Minister's Condition of Approval No. 27(construction hours) to extend construction hours between the hours of 7am and 8pm Monday to Friday and between the hours of 7am and 4pm on Saturdays and Sundays on Alice Street between the Frome Street Roundabout and Morton Street, Moree.

SCHEDULE 2

The approval is modified by:

1. Replacing existing condition 1 with a new condition 1, as follows:

1. The Activity must be carried out consistent with:

- a) the procedures, safeguards and mitigation measures identified in the EIS, as modified by the Representations Report;
- b) *Moree town centre bypass Gwydir Highway connection, Modification to the Approved Project Environmental Assessment October 2009, RTA/Pub 09.409* prepared by the NSW Roads and Traffic Authority;
- c) *Moree town centre bypass Gwydir Highway connection, Modification to the Approved Project Environmental Assessment - submissions report March 2010, RTA/Pub 10.070* prepared by the NSW Roads and Traffic Authority;
- d) the RTA's modification request and assessment information dated 27 September 2010 supplemented by correspondence the RTA provided on 16 October 2010 to extend construction hours for one month along Alice Street between the Frome Street Roundabout and Morton St (08_0117 MOD 2); and
- e) the Conditions of this Approval.

The conditions of this approval prevail in the event of any inconsistency with the requirements for the Construction and Operation of the Activity arising out of the documents described in (a) to (d) above. Of any of the documents listed from (a) to (d) inclusive, the most recent document shall prevail to the extent of any inconsistency.

2. Replacing existing condition 27 with a new condition 27, as follows:

27. All construction activities, including entry and departure of heavy vehicles are restricted to the hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm (Monday to Friday); 8:00 am to 1:00 pm (Saturday) and at no time on Sundays and public holidays.

Notwithstanding the above, construction activities are permitted between the hours of 7:00am and 8:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am and 4:00pm on Saturday and Sunday along Alice Street between the Frome Street Roundabout and Morton Street, for a period one month from the date of this approval, or as otherwise agreed by the Director-General.

Works outside these hours that may be permitted include:

- (a) any works which do not cause noise emissions to be audible at any nearby residential property;
- (b) the delivery of materials which is required outside these hours as requested by Police or other authorities for safety reasons;
- (c) emergency work to avoid the loss of lives, property and/or to prevent environmental harm; and,
- (d) any other work as agreed through the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Sub Plan Process.

Local residents should be informed of the timing and duration of works covered under clause (d) at least 48 hours prior to commencement.
