I refer to the Boral Cement Tyre Chip Trial Monthly Reports #4 and #5 submitted to the Department on 28 June 2022 and 28 July 2022, respectively, in accordance with condition 1.4CA of the consent (DA401-11-2002-i, as modified). The Department acknowledges receipt of these reports.

The Department has reviewed the reports in consultation with the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) (refer EPA correspondence attached) and notes that no further trials have been conducted since January 2022.

It is acknowledged there has been some delays in completing the trial, however, the Department notes that Boral intends to complete the trial by the end of July, which is within the six-month timeframe stipulated for the trial period in condition 1.4CA. The final report on the trial must be submitted via the Department's Major Projects Post Approval portal no later than the end of August 2022.
