DA 504-00 Development Consent – Notification– LDP002 Exceedance

In accordance with Schedule 5, Condition 5A, of the Clarence Underground Coal Mine Development Consent (**DA 504-00**), Clarence Coal Pty Ltd (**Clarence**) hereby notifies the Department of Planning and Environment (**the department**) and other relevant parties of an exceedance of water concentration limits at Licence Discharge Point 002 (**LDP002**).

Clarence was conducting monthly water monitoring in accordance with the Water Management Plan. A sample collected from LDP002 on the 11th of June 2024 indicated slightly elevated levels of dissolved zinc, cobalt, nickel and total phosphorus.

Clarence understands the requirement of providing the Department with a report of the incident within 7 days of submitting a trigger notification.
