Dear Ms O'Rorke, thank you for notifying Precinct about the Luna Park DA's. Although Precinct does not meet until the 30th March, a sub group has reviewed the documents on line and found nothing major to say about the plans. I found the plans somewhat high-level, so would just like to comment on the Wild Mouse as follows :

- a) the western facade should not encroach on the boardwalk more than the present western facade
- b) would removing some of the wall release more mechanical noise from the mouse? Not a good thing if so
- c) I thought the original concept for the wild mouse was to have it sitting on top of a stylised yellow cheese. It was painted blue ages ago. Now the faux rusticated castellation is a further departure.
