

## EXHIBITION OF MODIFICATION APPLICATION

### Ravensthorpe South – Landform Amendment

<b>Application No</b>	DA86-51-Mod-1
<b>Location</b>	Ravensthorpe, NSW
<b>Applicant</b>	AGL Macquarie Pty Limited
<b>Council Area</b>	Singleton Shire
<b>Consent Authority</b>	Minister for Planning

#### Description of the development consent

The original 1986 Ravensthorpe South Coal Mine approval includes:

- a 20-year mine life from the date the original consent was granted;
- transport of all coal via conveyor between the mine site and Coal Lease 106;
- realignment of Lemington Road and associated services; and
- realignment of Bayswater Creek.

#### Description of proposed modification

The proposed modification application involves:

- changes to ash emplacement methodology;
- removal of redundant pumping infrastructure;
- provision for the receipt, stockpiling and use of capping material for Void 5;
- vegetation clearing to enable ongoing ash deposition in Void 5;
- introduction of flexible options for the Void 5 final landform; and
- updating the boundary of DA86-51 to reflect current land tenure and rehabilitation requirements.

#### About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (Department) has received an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development. The application and accompanying documents (including the Modification report) are on exhibition from **Thursday 16 June 2022** until **Saturday 2 July 2022**.
