Land:	Part Lot 5 DP1104199
Development:	Redevelopment of Stockton Boat Harbour involving demolition of the existing boat harbour and jetty, reconstruction of revetment walls, installation of floating berths and maintenance dredging/excavation to improve existing navigational depths.
Modification:	DA 8796-2017 MOD 1: Demolition of 5.3 metre section of seawall which was uncovered during the excavation works associated with DA 8796-2019 and not previously identified. It is noted this Modification Consent applies to land under State Environmental Planning Policy (Three Ports) 2013 under Part 4 of the EP&A Act.

SCHEDULE 2

The consent (DA 8796-2017) is modified as follows:

- (a) In Part A, Condition A2 is amended by the insertion of the **bold and underlined** words / numbers as follows:

A2. The Applicant shall carry out the development:

- c) in accordance with the SEE and its associated plans, **except as amended by the following plans prepared by Royal HaskoningDHV:**

- d) in accordance with the management and mitigation measures.

- (b) Part B is amended by the insertion of the **bold and underlined** words / numbers as follows

B27. Prior to the commencement of the removal of the heritage seawall, the Applicant shall prepare a Heritage Archival Recording in accordance with NSW Heritage Office's How to Prepare Archival Records of Heritage Items (1998) and Photographic Recording of Heritage Items Using Film or Digital Capture (2006).

Within 12 months of completing the archival recording, the Applicant must submit the Heritage Archival Recording to the Council and relevant local libraries in the local government area.
