

EXHIBITION OF STATE SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION AL-FAISAL COLLEGE REDEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION

Description of proposal

Redevelopment and expansion of Al-Faisal College comprising:

- staged redevelopment and expansion of the existing school at 83-87 Gurner Avenue, including:
 - demolition of an existing dwelling and expansion of the school at 79 Gurner Avenue;
 - demolition of existing school buildings, tree removal and site earthworks;
 - alterations and additions to existing school buildings and construction of a new three-storey building to create general learning areas (GLAs) for Years 1-6, shared activity spaces, storage areas and staff and student amenities;
 - construction of a new two-storey Kindergarten building and a new single-storey multi-purpose school hall;
 - construction of a basement car park with access from Fourth Avenue and bus bays along Gurner Avenue;
 - drop-off and pick-up area and main pedestrian entry from Fourth Avenue; and
 - provision of a playing field with seating and change facilities, various play areas, landscaping works, circulation areas, fencing and signage.
- staged construction of a new secondary school at 66 & 80 Gurner Avenue, including:
 - demolition of an existing dwelling, tree removal and site earthworks;
 - construction of a new four-storey building to create the main school reception and administration area,
 offices and meeting rooms, lecture theatre, library, GLAs, staff and student amenities and roof terraces;
 - construction of two new three-storey buildings to create GLAs for Years 7-12, shared activity spaces, canteens, storage areas and staff and student amenities;
 - construction of two new single-storey multi-purpose school halls;
 - construction of basement car parking with access from Gurner Avenue and West Avenue;
 - provision of bus bays along Gurner Avenue and main pedestrian entry from West Avenue; and
 - provision of a playing field with seating and change facilities, outdoor multi-purpose sports courts, various play areas, landscaping, circulation areas, fencing and signage.
- staged increase in student numbers to a maximum of 5460 students by 2042 across the two sites, including 2940 primary school students and 2520 secondary school students.
