Over the past four years my wife and I have lived in Anzac Village Narrabeen. We decided to retire here after seeing it's natural beauty and wildlife, situated on Collaroy Plateau next to park and bushland overlooking Narrabeen Lake and the ocean.

We are now faced with a development of huge proportions which will impact the enjoyment of our retirement for the next fifteen years. The Village is going to become a building site with all those disturbances associated with it's activities. Noise and dust from heavy vehicles including trucks, excavators, bulldozers, rock hammering and drilling rigs, chain saws and woodchippers. Interruptions to services and access to the village.

RSL Lifecare has advised us that 460 trees are to be removed in stage 1 when in fact up to 1669 trees may be affected by root disturbance from excavations. { ref: Arboricultural Impact Statement } The loss of these trees will also reduce the number of perching birds such as Rainbow Lorikeets, Whip birds, Kookaburras, Orioles Tawny Frogmouths, as well as varieties of Owls that live here. Climate change is a reality with warmer temperatures predicted for Australia. Removing so many trees displays an ignorance and deniability of what is happening. The existing old growth mature trees provide invaluable shade and protection for the residents of the Village whilst removing CO2 from the atmosphere. New tree plantings will never be able to replace them.

Many of the older residents of Anzac Village are unable to make a submission and the proposed development by RSL Lifecare is very distressing for them and many have become ill. This is not the way that RSL Lifecare should be treating it's elderly residents. In fact you could say this is a form of age discrimination. Also, the inadequate time frame of two weeks for a submission to be presented favours the developer and The Department of Planning and Infrastructure by reducing the number of submissions.

When we bought into RSL Lifecare Anzac Village we were not informed of their "Master Plan" and future developments for the Village. Surely it was their duty to do so.

We now face an uncertain future living in an ongoing building site for the next 15 years.
