

Hospital precinct audit checklist

DESCRIPTION: A site assessment is an important first step in assessing the travel and transport opportunities and challenges for your hospital or precinct. A site assessment can be as simple as walking around a workplace and surrounding area and recording information about how to get around on foot and all other modes of transport.

Note: Not all questions may be applicable to your hospital or precinct.
