Exhibition of Environmental Assessment for proposed modification to the Ardmore Park Quarry - MODIFICATION 3 - PA 07_0155

Reference is made to your correspondence received on 12 January 2018 advising that the Environmental Assessment for the above proposal prepared by R W Corkery & Co was on public exhibition. That document has now been reviewed.

I note that previous Heritage Council advice, dated August 2008, identified that no items of European heritage significance were identified on the Project Site and that commitments made in the Environmental Assessment report were considered generally acceptable to manage the heritage impacts if the Ardmore Park Quarry Project was approved.

The proposed modification seeks to: increase the extraction area by 3.5ha to increase total resource extraction; increase production limits; extend transportation hours; extend the quarry life to 2047; install additional infrastructure on site; and accept Excavated Natural Material (EMM) on to the site, and amend the wording of some existing administrative conditions.

I also note that our letter responding to the request for SEARs dated 4 August 2017, advised that because no sites of heritage significance exist within the proposed extraction area extension that specific requirements related to heritage matters did not need to be addressed for the proposed modification.
