- **NO** Surgical Services

In November 1999, the Brunswick Valley and Byron Bay Community Consultative Committees agreed to support the concept of one central hospital for the Byron Shire. They were advised ***“The new 54-bed Central Hospital will replace the ageing facilities at Byron Bay and Mullumbimby and provide the residents of Byron Shire with an enhanced and expanded range of services”*** (Northern Rivers Area Health Service, Byron Shire Central Hospital, Community News Update March 2002)
