Description of proposal

The proposal includes:

Construction of two wharves on piles, one at La Perouse and one at Kurnell that would comprise

- A berth for passenger ferries (to cater for ferries between 15 metres to 40 metres in length);
 - A multi-user berth for commercial and recreational vessels (to cater for vessels between 2 metres and 20 metres long);
 - Sheltered waiting areas and associated furniture; and
 - Associated signage and lighting.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment is exhibiting a State Significant Infrastructure (SSI) application, Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and accompanying documents from **Wednesday 14 July 2021** until **Wednesday 11 August 2021**.

At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has not directed that a public hearing should be held.

Development in NSW can be subject to Commonwealth legislation, depending on the circumstances.

The Commonwealth Minister for the Environment, has decided that the proposed development Kamay Ferry Wharves Project within Kamay Botany Bay National Park, Sydney, NSW is a “controlled action” under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act)*

This means that the proposed SSI, in being assessed under Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, must also accord with the Bilateral Agreement between NSW and the Commonwealth, made under the EPBC Act. The assessment will follow the process specified in Schedule 1 of the Bilateral Agreement.
