### GLEDELL CONTINUED OPERATIONS PROJECT AND MOUNT OWEN CONTINUED OPERATIONS PROJECT (MODIFICATION 4)

#### Description of proposal

The proposal involves the expansion of the Glendell open cut coal mine. The project includes:

- Extending the Glendell Pit to the north to extract an additional 135 million tonnes of run-of-mine (ROM) coal over the life of the project;
- Extending the life of the Glendell Mine until December 2044;
- Continued use of the Mount Owen coal handling and processing plant (CHPP), mine infrastructure area and rail and extending the life of these facilities;
- Extracting and transporting up to 10 million tonnes per annum of ROM coal to the Mount Owen CHPP for processing and dispatch by rail;
- Increasing the approved disturbance footprint by approximately 750 hectares;
- Additional overburden emplacement within the Glendell Pit and Ravensworth East emplacement areas;
- Constructing a new mine infrastructure area;
- Relocating the Ravensworth Homestead;
- Realigning Hebden Road and Yorks Creek; and
- Changes to the approved final landform.
