Description of the development consent

Increasing the capacity of the existing construction and demolition waste and commercial and industrial waste resource recovery facility.

Description of proposed modification

The proposed section 4.55(2) modification application involves the extension of operation hours for the loading and transport of sorted material off site from 7:00am – 6:00pm Monday to Saturday and 8:00am – 4:00pm Sunday, to 24 hours per day 7 days per week. The proposed modification also involves upgrades to the lighting infrastructure, and the expansion of waste types processed at the site to include rubber, thermosets and composites.

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (Department) is exhibiting an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development (SSD).
