Description of proposal

The above State significant development (SSD) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was exhibited from Thursday 24 October 2019 until Wednesday 20 November 2019. The Applicant (TAFE NSW) has submitted a Response to Submissions (RtS) that responds to the comments made in submissions lodged by government agencies and the public. The RtS also includes amendments to the proposed development.

Amendments to the proposal include:

- Inclusion of a new separate two storey car park on See Street with three levels of car parking totalling 241 spaces;
- Reduction of proposed car parking spaces and size of basement level floor plates for level 01 and 02 within the Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub;
- Removal of 113 trees to accommodate the Multi-Trades and Digital Technology Hub and separate two storey car park; and
- Changes to the SSD application boundary to include the footprint of the new multi-storey carpark.

The application, RtS and accompanying documents will be exhibited from **Thursday 4 June 2020** until **Thursday 18 June 2020**, and are accessible electronically on the Department's website (https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/project/14386).

At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has not directed that a public hearing should be held.
