Description of proposal

The proposal involves the continuation of the existing Gunlake Quarry and includes:

- Extending the quarry life by 30 years;
 - Extracting and processing of up to 4.2 million tonnes per annum of hard rock;
 - Road transportation of quarry products to market;
 - 24-hour quarry operations Monday to Saturday except between 6 pm Saturday and 2 am Monday;
 - Direct employment of up to 228 full time equivalent personnel; and
 - Progressive rehabilitation of disturbed areas and the life of quarry rehabilitation.
