Heritage NSW:

Heritage NSW has reviewed the relevant documentation for MP08_0005-Mod-2 ACH – New Request for Advice - Pines Caravan Park (Coffs Harbour City) - Advice on Modification Report, with respect to Aboriginal cultural heritage. Heritage NSW has no additional comments or recommendations with respect to this modification.

EPA:

This application does not trigger the need for an Environment Protection Licence under Schedule 1 of the POEO Act and therefore the EPA has no formal comment.

The EPA would emphasise to the Consent Authority that all measures are undertaken to ensure adequate erosion and sediment control planning and implementation to protect the neighbouring Hearnes Lake and ultimately the Solitary Islands Marine Park.
