The exhibition of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the above proposal ended on 08 December 2021. The Department is currently reviewing the issues raised in the public submissions and agency advice and will provide separate advice identifying any key issues to be addressed in the submissions report.

We request a submissions report by 10 February 2022. Please lodge your submissions report by progressing the application on the major projects planning portal.

Note that the time between the date of this letter and the date the Secretary receives your response are not included in the period of 'deemed refusal', under clause 113(7) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000*.
