Description of proposal

The above State significant development (SSD) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was exhibited between 23 February 2021 and 22 March 2021. The Applicant has submitted an Amendment Report and Submissions Report that responds to the comments made in submissions by the public and government agency advice. Amendments to the proposal include:

- introduction of detailed childcare fit-out.
- interim use of the Miller Street/Carlow Street corner part of the site during construction staging.
- reduction in scale of the Miller Street building from a 5-storey building (including basement) to a 4-storey building (including basement) with a rooftop recreation space.
- facade amendments to the Miller Street Building.
- conversion of the level 1 terrace over the kitchen canteen to service space.
- minor design amendments including internal layout reconfiguration and changes to safety fencing and ramp access.
- landscaping amendments including additional tree retention and planting and introduction of landscaped steps next to the auditorium fover.
- increase width of the Miller Street pedestrian pathway with associated landscaping.
- increase in bicycle parking spaces from 82 to 109; and
- correction of the site legal description.

About the exhibition

The amended application and accompanying documents will be exhibited from **Tuesday 16 November 2021** until **Monday 13 December 2021** and are accessible electronically on the Department's website (www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/projects/on-exhibition).

At the time of publishing this exhibition notice, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has not directed that a public hearing should be held.
