Description of proposal

The SSD application involves the construction and operation of an expansion to an existing data centre, comprising:

- A five-storey building extension with ancillary office space;
- Supporting infrastructure and services, including back-up generators and diesel fuel storage; and
- Minor earthworks, additional car parking, hardstand areas and landscaping.
