ATTACHMENT 1 Department's Comments

Odour

- 1. The Department notes that rubber smell from the asphalt plant has been cited as a concern by the public, consistent with the observation reported in the audit report submitted as part of the modification application. It is requested the Applicant provide the following information in the RTS:
 - a. sources of odour generation, including clarification around the potential for crumb rubber asphalt fumes to impact neighbouring sensitive receptors
 - b. quantitative comparison of odour and air quality impacts between the original approval, current operation and proposed modification
 - c. any required odour management and mitigation measures.

Input materials used for asphalt production

2. It is requested the Applicant provide a detailed comparison of input materials used for asphalt production between the original approval, current operation and proposed modification.
