Dear Sir,

Issues raised in relation to the Security design and associated responses below.

- D. The amenity of the lower level ground 2 Parkside Crescent accessible lift entry has improved with the double volume void and high-level windows. Still, the dead-end corridor could be a safety concern. Please ask the proponent to improve crime prevention through environmental design for this entry.

It is not possible to design out the dead end corridor due to architectural constraints. The main entry and lift lobby present opportunities for Natural Surveillance due to the extent of glazing, and CCTV cameras will be installed to enable this area to be monitored in real time, and to provide recorded images in the event of an incident occurring.

- KK. The design for the accessible entrance has slightly improved. A double-height void space in this location (as shown in yellow) to increase light and make it a grander feeling entrance. This entrance could still be a security concern.

The risk cannot be designed out by changes to the architecture, therefore CCTV surveillance should be provided to facilitate a greater level of perceived safety to users of the space, and for evidentiary purposes in the event that a security incident occurs.
