Description of proposal

The SSD application involves the construction and operation of an advanced manufacturing research facility comprising a manufacturing hall, administrative workspaces and an exhibition/event space. The facility would support the development of the advanced manufacturing sector within the Western Sydney Aerotropolis by housing shared high-tech manufacturing equipment for research and development. The proposal also includes site preparation works, site access and parking, utilities infrastructure, landscaping/public domain, signage and other ancillary works.
