Description of the development consent

Upgrade of the existing Springvale Coal Services Site coal handling facility and construction of a private haul road.

Description of proposed modification

The proposed modification involves redesigning the site water management system in order to:

- reduce discharge of water from the Springvale Coal Services Site;
- enable the receipt of water from Angus Place Water Transfer System; and
- enable the transfer of water to Mount Piper Power Station and McPhillamys Gold Project for reuse.

The Department of Planning and Environment (Department) is exhibiting an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development (SSD).
