Description of the development consent

To develop, operate and rehabilitate an open cut and underground gold mine and associated infrastructure, including extracting and processing up to 1.5 million tonnes of gold ore per year for up to 31 December 2025 and transporting the processed ore from the site via road.

Description of proposed modification

Increasing capacity of the Residue Storage Facility 1 (RSF1) by about 400,000 tonnes through construction and use of RSF1 Stage 9 Cell 2 within the approved project site.
