Description of the development consent

Development of the New Inner Sydney High School, comprising:

- redevelopment of the existing Cleveland Street Intensive English High School
- demolition of Building 4 and associated covered walkways
- adaptive reuse of existing heritage-listed buildings, and
- a proposed new 13 storey building, including basement and rooftop basketball court.

Description of proposed modification

The modification application seeks approval for use of external LED lighting fixtures on the northern, eastern and western facades of the school building for school and community special occasions and events.

The Department of Planning and Environment is exhibiting an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development (SSD).
