With regards to the alleged new project proposal for a new school (Minarah College) on Catherine Field Rd, Catherine Filed.

We totally oppose, Reasons below.

I have lived in Catherine Field for 35 years, we used our land for primary production, I have helped my parents on the farm & have always enjoyed the freedom of country life, it's a peaceful rural area where people choose to keep animals, ride their bikes & simply enjoy the peaceful living.

Due to increased traffic on Catherine Field Rd, (Particularly after the removal of the right-hand turn access from Springfield Rd) consequently the traffic on Catherine Field Rd is now 50% heavier, some days it seems like the traffic never stops.

The road cannot handle the increased traffic, the roads were not constructed to handle heavy traffic, Roads are riddled with potholes & in constant repair. I know of many whom have damaged their vehicles, avoiding them is impossible, driving into them is inevitable.

There is no sewer in the area, Daily Septic tanks flushes will add to increased traffic & smell?

No streetlights, no kerbs or guttering.

Catherine Fields is a peaceful rural environment, the school will convert the area to a noise bomb, the increased traffic will potentially cause more accidents, the proposed project is basically a NOT FIT to the area.

A school would change the scope of the area & convert it suburbia, yet the area is NOT ZONED as residential housing development. The area is zoned as RURAL.
