In the preparation of the SR and AR, the Department requests that it be involved in Transport for NSW's engagement with agencies so as to improve its understanding of key issues and how these matters are to be resolved. The Department should be present at meetings with agencies and on key issues which:

- · consider an agency's advice (prior to SR and AR preparation); and
- present further assessment and the proposed changes to mitigation and management measures (prior to the submission of the SR and AR).
