Description of proposal

Concept development application for redevelopment of the existing hospital, including:

- A concept proposal comprising:
 - two building envelopes including an approximately 39.5 metre (RL 136.5) hospital building envelope and an approximately 24.9 metre (RL 116.2) multi-level carpark envelope.
 - demolition and refurbishment of existing buildings, including Denistone House.
 - site layout and access arrangements.
 - landscaping and vegetation removal.
- Concurrent Stage 1 works comprising:
 - demolition of buildings 11, 17 and 18.
 - installation of temporary buildings.
 - site preparation works, including tree removal.
 - bulk earthworks, shoring and internal roads.
 - construction access from Ryedale Road.
 - utility works.
 - temporary at-grade parking.

The Department of Planning and Environment has received a State significant development (SSD) application for the abovementioned proposal.
