Description of the development consent

Construction and operation of an underground gold mine and associated infrastructure, including extraction and processing of up to 355,000 tonnes of ore per year, transportation of the ore from the mine via public roads, and progressive rehabilitation of the project area.

Description of proposed modification

Increase processing rate by 60,000 tonnes per year, changes to water management, including construction and operation of a water management dam and provisions for emergency trucking of water to the site and administrative amendments to the consent.

The Department of Planning and Environment (Department) has received an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development.
