I OBJECT to the modification of the Liverpool Range Wind Farm for the following reasons:

- ① Visual Pollution - as the towers proposed now are much higher they will be impacting on the views from the town and surrounds much more
- ② Noise Pollution: the noise from the turbines will have an impact on the health of locals
- ③ Environmental: the concrete block will remain in the ground indefinitely. Habitat destruction for wildlife will be a major factor, especially for our beautiful wedgetail eagles, at the new

height proposed. Many of our ^{larger} birds will be impacted as will our native bats.

(4) Impact on roads: Longer blades, heavier towers will mean more damage to our already fragile road system

(5) Putting one in our National Park will destroy the fragile eco system as the new towers will be so high and noisy

(6) Many areas of farmland will become unusable because the noise from the much larger turbines will make it impossible to run animals in the area. And the extra land needed for the cement pads will mean the land can't be farmed.
