Description of infrastructure approval

The Port Kembla Gas Terminal is an approved liquefied natural gas (LNG) import terminal. The infrastructure approval allows Australian Industrial Energy (AIE) to demolish and re-construct an existing shipping berth in Port Kembla to accommodate larger vessels. Materials excavated in the demolition and construction of the berth may be transported by barge to an emplacement area in the outer harbour of Port Kembla.

Description of proposed modification

The proposed modification would allow AIE to transport some of the excavated material to a sea dumping site located 8-10 kilometres offshore.

AIE is also seeking separate approval from the Commonwealth Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) to allow dumping to occur in Commonwealth waters.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (Department) has received an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant infrastructure. The application and accompanying documents (including the modification report) are on exhibition from **Friday 16 September 2022** until **Thursday 29 September 2022**. At the time of publishing this notice, the Minister for Planning has not directed that a public hearing should be held.
