intensive form of power generation , emitting 1.7 times as much greenhouse gases (GHGs) per unit of electricity produced compared to coal fired power plants. The cost of energy generation is nearly four times higher than solar power and onshore wind energy, twice as much as natural gas, and 25 percent more expensive than coal fired power plants. I strongly object to Veolia's proposed incinerator being built in Tarago.

I believe that Veolia's toxic industrial waste incinerator poses a health risk to humans and animals in the region.

Of particular concern are the following:

- 1. The incinerator proposal will emit toxic air pollution which will spread throughout the region.
- 2. Pollution from the proposed incinerator could lead to damage to lung function, cardiac disease and death. In addition to polluting the air, toxins may build up in the environment over time in soil and water.
- 3. Food contaminated by incinerator toxins can cause cancer, miscarriage, infant deaths, developmental delays, reproductive issues, heart disease and respiratory impairment.
- 4. Veolia's record of polluting local groundwaters (EPA prevention notice in October 2022) proves they cannot be trusted to safely manage this project.
- 5. The incinerator will cause an intergenerational burden and legacy of toxins which cannot be allowed to go ahead.
