To Officers of the NSW Govt

I wish to lodge my objection to the proposal by Veolia to process waste at Tarago through an incineration process. Science is telling us 'loud and clear' that we should not be releasing carbon into the atmosphere, as an incinerator must do. There are other new and available processes available for industry to otherwise recycle waste, turn it into new and precious material while minimising carbon emissions.

I don't think Veolia's argument that the 75 thousand tonnes of greenhouse gases created is less than if it went to landfill is valid in this age of meeting net zero emissions targets - we shouldn't be sending waste to landfill that creates that much greenhouse gases. Veolia does not encourage its customers to create less waste or recycle waste more to achieve a sustainable economy.
