Recently the Matraville plans in Sydney were abandoned because of public backlash, why is Tarago less important?

The plans will create 2.2million tonnes of toxic waste ash, including 380,000 tonnes of air pollution control residue (fly ash) which is classified as hazardous waste by the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA)

This will be concentrated to one area running the risk of soil and groundwater as well as the Sydney water catchment. This also has implications for wildlife

This is NOT how we should be treating rubbish in 2022- it is dangerous and not in the public interest

The proposal should be firmly rejected
